

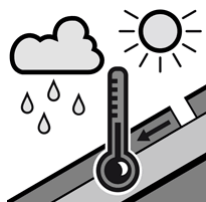

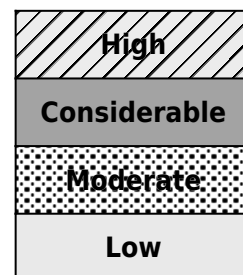
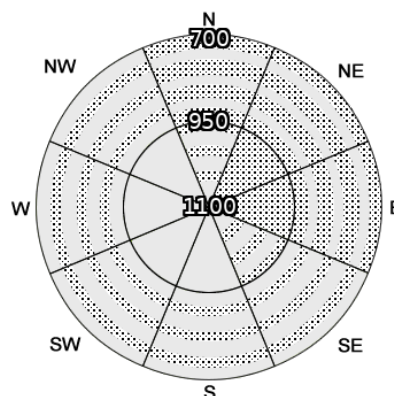
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cooler temperatures will help consolidate the old snowpack in all locations above 950m. At lower elevations all old snow will remain moist and moderately stabilised. New windslab will form on very sheltered North to East aspects above 950m and where it acquires depth it will be marginally bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Cooler overnight with some snow showers. Dry during the day but with a gradual rise in the freezing level to around summits level. Very strong South-West winds.

Comments

Significant snow loss in all locations after heavy thaw and rain. Effective snow line 700m on Friday. Freezing level 900m overnight rising steadily to 1100m during the day.
