

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 800 metres. Instabilities in the snowpack will increase during the morning as the freezing level rises and rain falls at all levels. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Very strong South-Westerly winds will back South-South-Westerly during the morning. Showers are expected to fall as snow above 800 metres overnight and during the morning before the freezing level rises above the summits and persistent rain falls at all levels.
