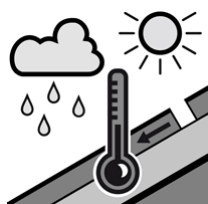


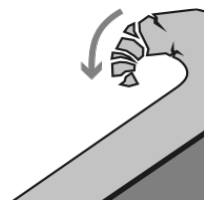

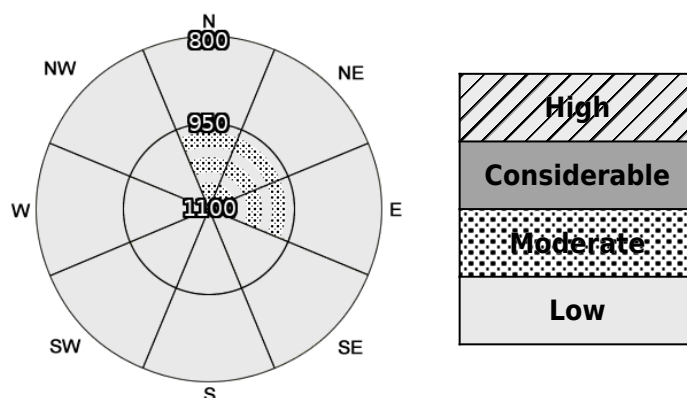
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some localised, loose wet snow instabilities will exist on steepest North to East aspects above 950 metres. At lower elevations all old snow will remain moist consolidated and generally well stabilised. Any cornices will be suspect during thaw conditions. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Thawing conditions with freezing levels rising well above summits overnight and during the day. Rain showers will die away by mid morning to give a dry although windy day; strong South-Westerly winds throughout.

Comments

Mild in the coires - still wintry on summits!
