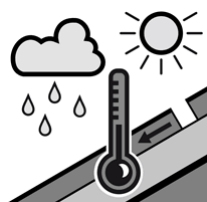


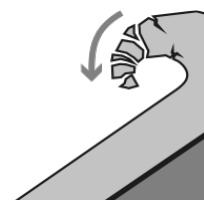

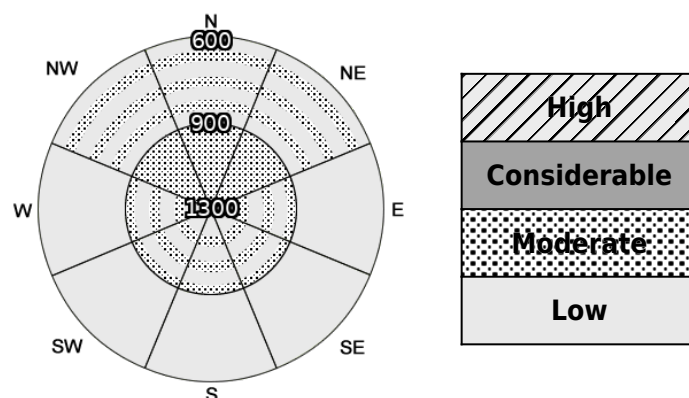
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw at all levels. Localised wet snow instabilities will remain in areas of sheltered steep and convex terrain above 900 metres with North-Westerly to North-East aspects being especially affected. Large unstable cornices will overhang these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

After a cooler spell overnight with some light snowfall the freezing level will rise to well above the summits. Winds will be strong to gale force South to South-Westerly. Rain at all levels early morning, this will clear to leave a dry day.
