



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh areas of unstable windslab will develop overnight, greatest accumulations being on sheltered North-West, North, North-East and East aspects above 900m. During Tuesday, these deposits will become increasingly unstable with the rising temperatures. Avalanches are likely in these locations. Localised wet snow instabilities will remain on other steep aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong winds through there will be period of snowfall overnight above 600m but this will quickly turn to rain at all levels on Tuesday morning. South or South-West winds remaining strong.
