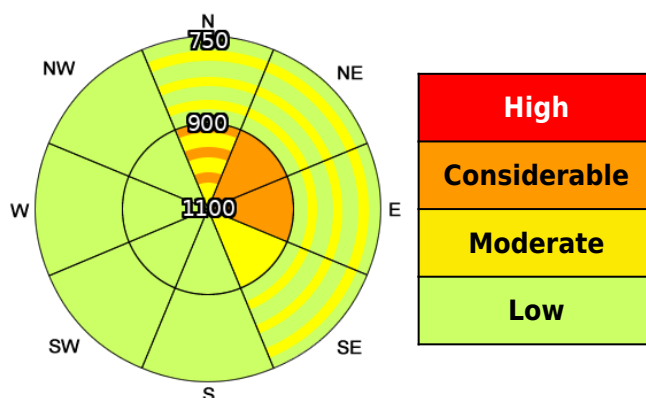

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New multilayered, moderately bonded windslab development will occur on steep and sheltered North to East aspects above 750m. Stability will deteriorate in these locations as the day progresses. Some new soft cornice development expected over steepest lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Further snow showers overnight, these will become heavy at times later in the day. Cold to start with freezing levels rising slowly to around summits by end of the period. Winds will be strong generally South-Westerly.

Comments

A light general covering only above 600m, further snow expected.
