

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of unstable windslab will develop during the day. Greatest accumulations will be on sheltered North, North-East and East aspects above 900m. Further instabilities will develop as the freezing level rises during the day. Avalanches are likely in these locations. Unstable cornices will also form above these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Increasing strength South-Westerly winds throughout the forecast period. The freezing level will slowly rise to around 1100m with moderate accumulations of fresh snow.
