

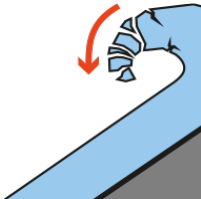

Avalanche Problems



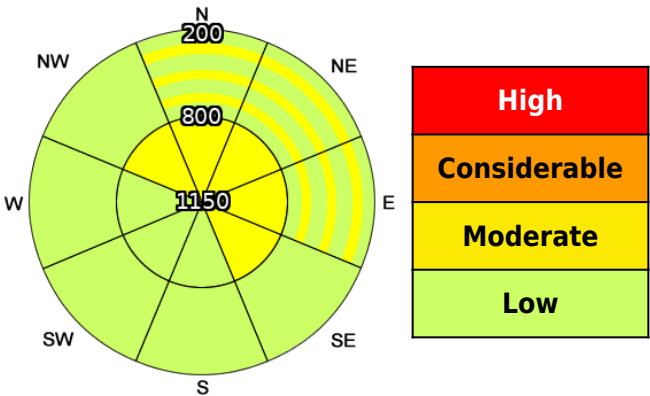
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderately bonded windslab will continue to develop on steep and sheltered North to East aspects, mainly above 800 metres. Other slope aspects will have localised instabilities and gully exits and steep corrie headwalls will be affected by cross loading due to the strong winds. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will become colder with the freezing level lowering to around 200 metres then rising slightly to 500 metres. Snow showers tonight will continue through the period accompanied by strong gale force West-South-Westerly winds.

Comments

Snow showers and severe gales with fluctuating freezing levels for the next few days.
