

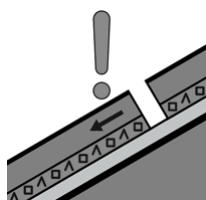

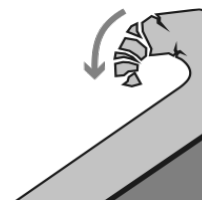
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



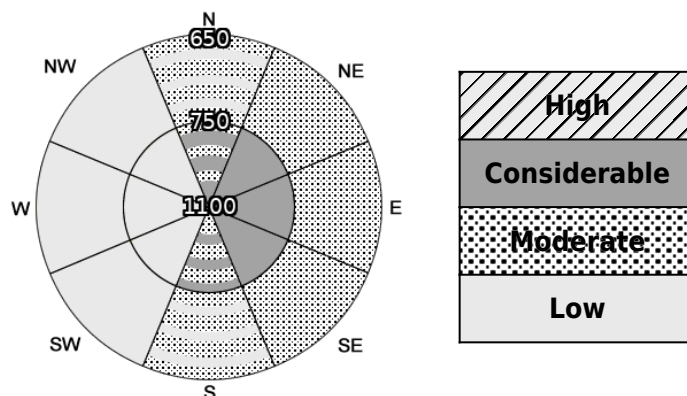
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cold temperatures will maintain instability on all North-East to South-East aspects above 750m. Localised instability will also remain on selected sheltered North and South facing slopes and gullies. All new cornices will be large and prone to sudden collapse. Much better stability on recently scoured slopes and ridge lines. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers dying out overnight. Winds easing to moderate and becoming West North-Westerly, later generally Westerly. Staying cold throughout.

Comments

Challenging mountain conditions again today. Rain below 550m and constant snow and drifting above 650m. Less wind tomorrow.
