

Wind Slab




Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable snow will be present, mainly at the tops of steep North-East, East and South-East aspects above 900m. Localised accumulations will also be present on other steep aspects. Instabilities will develop further during the day as the freezing level rises. Avalanches are likely in these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate winds from a generally South-Westerly direction. Overnight snow showers will give way to rain at all levels by mid morning on Thursday.
