

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Overnight, the snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate at all levels. As the freezing level drops during the morning, Fresh areas of unstable windslab will develop mainly at the tops of steep North, North-East and East aspects above 900m. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



**Forecast Weather Influences**

South-West winds will strengthen overnight before easing again during the day. Rain at all levels turning to snow above 600m in the morning.
