

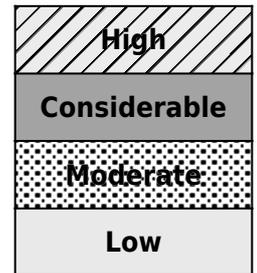


Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A period of wet snow instability is expected overnight and early in the morning. Cornices will be prone to collapse during this period. The existing snowpack will then consolidate as the freezing level lowers. However, fresh areas of unstable windslab will be deposited on North to East aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and early in the morning it will be mild with heavy rain at all levels. Late morning, and through the afternoon the freezing level will drop with showers turning to snow above 500 metres.
