### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 06/02/2016

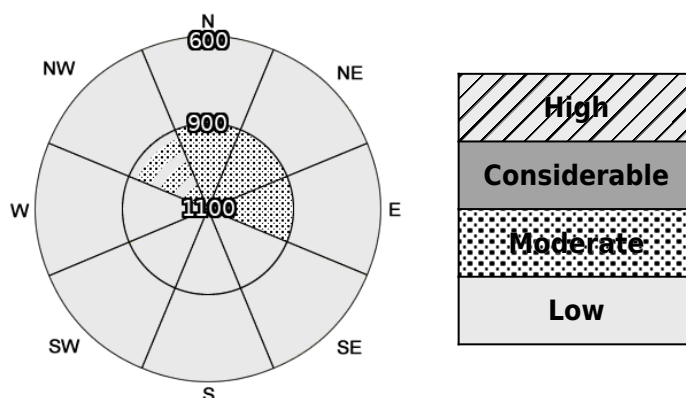
#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist snowpack will refreeze and become stable in all locations. Some new marginally bonded windslab will form on North-West through North to East aspects above 900m. Most affected areas expected to be North to East facing gullies exits and the top of steeper scarp slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming much colder and remaining so throughout. Freezing levels around 600 metres. A little light snowfall on moderate South West winds, backing South East later in the day.

#### Comments

Friday a very wet day but some late light snowfall with the arrival of colder air. Freezing level projected to be 600m overnight and during the day. Some uncertainty over forecasted snow amounts - check up to date weather reports Saturday am to verify.
