

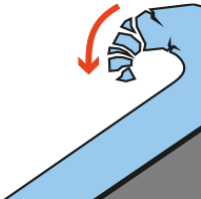

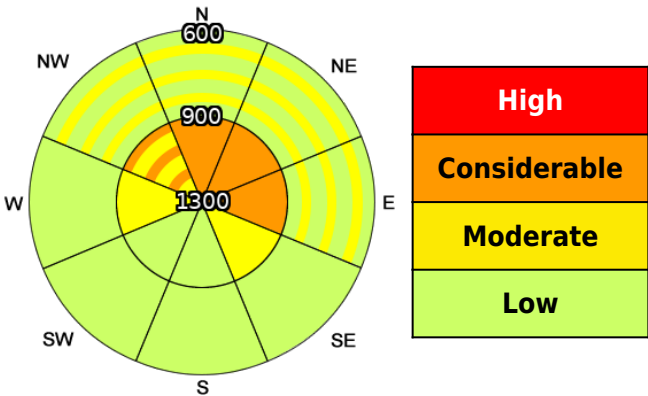
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderate to weakly bonded windslab will continue to develop on North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Corrie rims gully tops and scarp slopes will be particularly affected. More localised windslab will form on other aspects due to cross loading. Fragile cornices will develop. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snowfall will continue throughout the forecast period. Strong to gale force South winds will veer West-South-Westerly during the afternoon. The freezing level will rise to summit levels briefly overnight before falling to around 600 metres.

Comments

Continuous light snowfall for most of the day.
