

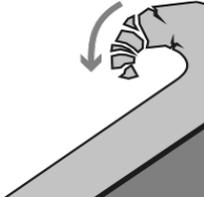



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Initially poorly bonded windslab will continue to develop on steep sheltered North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Localised windslab will form in other areas due to cross loading. Through the day redistribution will form localised windslab onto East and South-East aspects. Unstable cornices will overhang these areas. Elsewhere the snowpack will be scoured firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Some light snow showers above 600 metres. Strong South-South-Westerly winds will decrease to moderate and veer West-North-Westerly through the day. The freezing level will be around 700 metres.
