

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow instabilities will form on sheltered steep terrain on all aspects above 800 metres throughout the period. Especially effected will be North - West through East to South aspects above 800 metres. Localised accumulations due to cross loading will affect many aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight winds will be moderate West - South - West backing North - East. Early morning until the end of the period winds will be fresh North - West. The freezing level will lower from 800 metres to around 500 metres. Light snow showers are expected overnight with a dry morning and further light showers in the afternoon.

Comments

Good ski snow both on and off piste, with occasional thin patches and exposed rocks.
