

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There may be a little redistribution of the existing snowpack during the afternoon with the strengthening winds. Otherwise little change is expected. Areas of poor and moderately bonded windslab will persist, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 900 meters. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a few overnight snow showers it will generally be a dry day. Strengthening winds will back to the North-West. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.

Cool and relatively settled conditions expected for the next few days.
