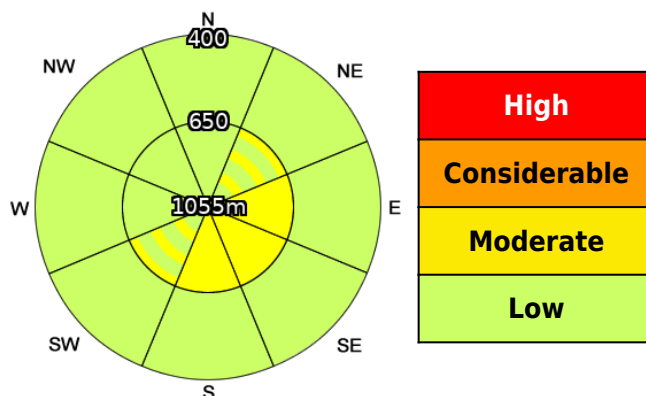

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh accumulations of unstable windslab will be deposited in steep sheltered locations above 650 metres mainly on East to South aspects. Most affected will be summit slopes, coire rims and gully exits. Localised areas of windslab will also develop on South-West and North-East aspects due to cross-loading. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate snowfall in the evening will ease into snow showers by midnight and will persist throughout the day. Strong Northerly winds overnight will also ease to around 15mph by daybreak, and back Westerly. The daytime freezing level will hover around 450 metres.

Comments

Moderate snowfall above 700 metres mid afternoon.
