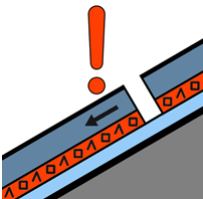

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 11/02/2016

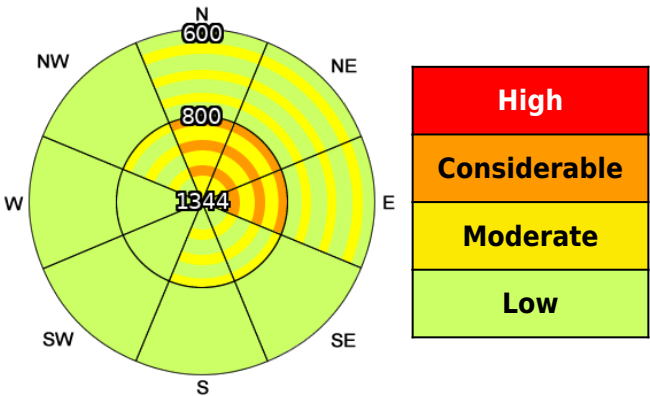
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable windslab will be present on some steep North, North-East and East aspects above 800m. Larger areas of unconsolidated and generally stable snow will be present in many other locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be around 400m with light to moderate Westerly winds overnight veering to the North-East and East during the day. No significant new snow expected.
