

Wind Slab





##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cold temperatures will preserve near surface instability in all recent windslab deposits on steep North East through East to South aspects above 800m. Some early consolidation expected in most snow accumulations below 700m. Wet snow instability later in the day on any very steep slopes exposed to sustained sunshine. Cornices will remain weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Staying very cold with occasional light snow showers. Winds will be moderate to strong North Westerly backing North Easterly, easing to moderate during the day.

##### Comments

Quite a lot of drifted snow on the Coire Ardair path this morning. Deep drifts in all sheltered locations. Access on foot very tiring if venturing away from the beaten track. Some warmth in the sun today.
