
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Redistribution of snow will occur building windslab on steep wind sheltered locations on South through West to North - West aspects above 600 metres. Moderately bonded localised instability remain on all other aspects above 600 metres especially on steep convex terrain, gully tops and coire rims. Cornices will continue to develop. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong East - North - East winds will veer Easterly, weakening overnight increasing in strength later in the day. There is a slight possibility of light snow showers later in the period. Freezing level will be around 300 to 400 metres.
