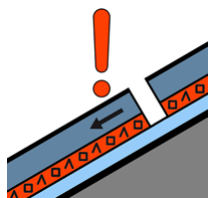

Persistent Weak Layers



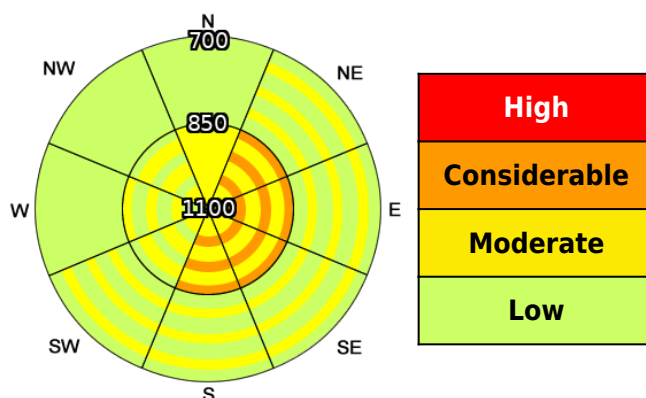

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cold temperatures will preserve near surface instability on steep North-East through East to South aspects above 850m. Further consolidation expected in most snow accumulations below 750m. Wet snow instability later in the day on any very steep slopes exposed to sustained sunshine. Cornices will remain weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Staying very cold throughout. Brighter during the day with some sunshine. A few light snow showers are possible much later in the period. Winds will be light to moderate Easterly increasing to moderate by the end of the day.

Comments

Covering of fresh snow at all levels on Thursday. Friday looking like a brighter day. Persistent solar warming of any steep sun-exposed slopes likely to induce some wet snow instability.
