

Wind Slab





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Redistribution of snow will cause unstable windslab to develop in sheltered locations mainly on South-West to North-West aspects above 700 metres. Other aspects will be affected with localised unstable accumulations due to cross loading. Localised instabilities will remain in the older snowpack mainly on steep North to East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Fresh to strong Easterly winds. Occasional snow showers most likely overnight. Freezing level around 400 metres.
