

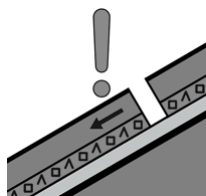

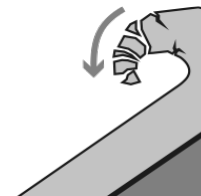

Wind Slab



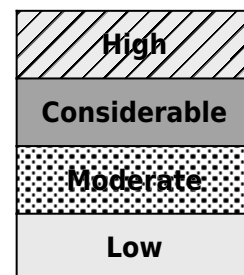
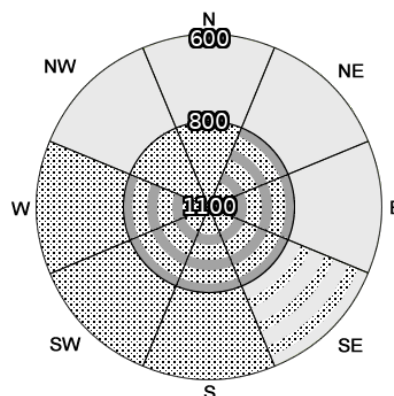

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will remain on many aspects above 800 metres. Deep deposits of moderately bonded windslab will persist on North-East to South-East aspects. Further deposits of soft poorly bonded windslab will accumulate on South to West aspects through the day. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

After a dry night snow showers are expected during the day. It will remain cold with a freezing level of around 300 metres. Moderate to strong winds will be from the North-East.

Comments

Conditions expected to stay cold Sunday and Monday, turning milder Tuesday.
