

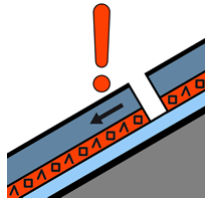

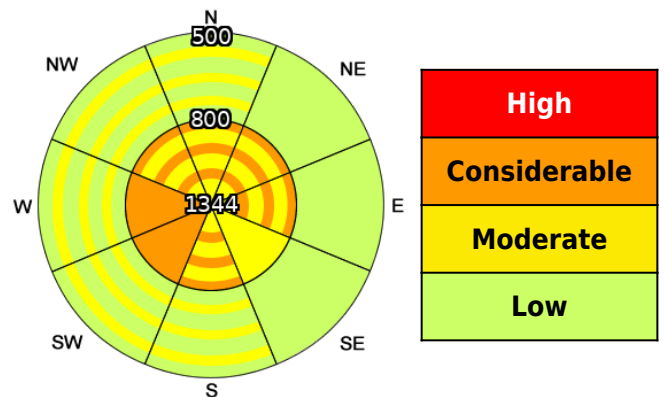
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will be present mainly at the tops of South-West and West facing slopes and gullies above 800 metres. On many other aspects, localised areas of unstable snow will be present, especially on crag aprons scarp slopes and gully exits. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate Northerly winds overnight will slowly die out during the period. It will be dry with freezing at all levels
