

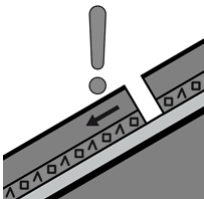

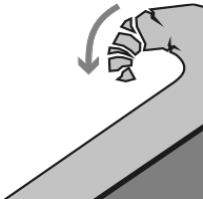

Wind Slab



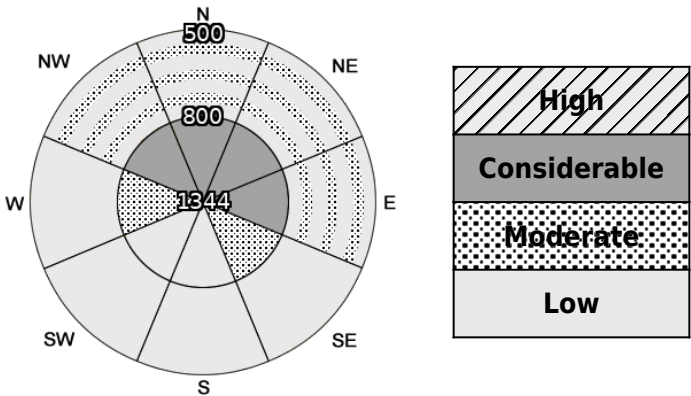
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will consolidate in the colder conditions. However, fresh areas of unstable windslab will be develop through the day on North-West through North to East aspects above 800 metres. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will drop to around 500 metres, where it will remain through the day. There will be snow showers through the period. Moderate to strong winds will be from between the South and the South-West.
