



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some consolidation in all older snow accumulations below 900m with onset of colder temperatures. Additional new weak windslab will be present on North-West through North to East aspects above 900m. Weak cornices above these locations. Better stability on wind exposed ridges and recently wind scoured slopes and gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds easing overnight to moderate South Westerly. Heavy snowfall overnight then lighter but persistent snow showers during the day. Progressively colder.

Comments

Freezing level falling from around summits overnight to 500m by the end of Weds.
