

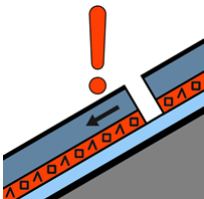

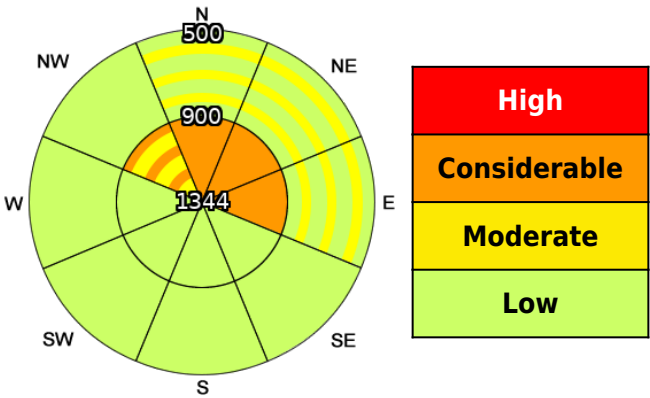
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will continue to form in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North, North-East and East aspects above 900m. Avalanches are likely in these locations. Wind blown old snow will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain around 500m with snow showers and moderate South-Westerly winds
