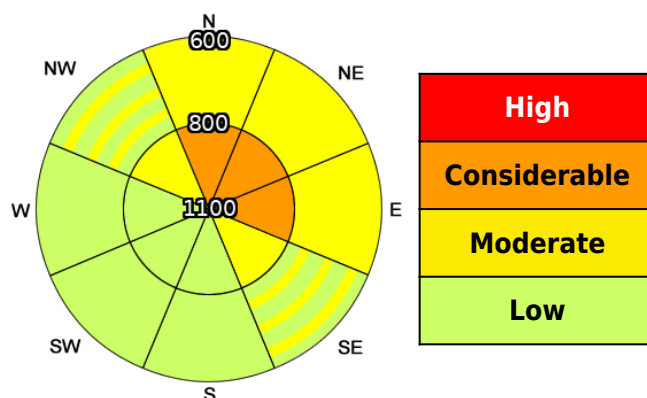
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will continue accumulate on mainly North to East aspects above 800 metres. Coire rims and gully tops will be most affected. Exposed windward aspects will tend to be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

A few snow showers are expected throughout the forecast period. Moderate winds will be from the South-West. The freezing level will be around 500 metres.
