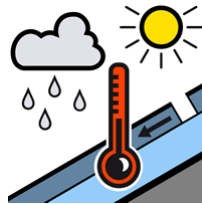

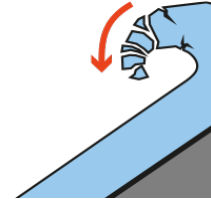

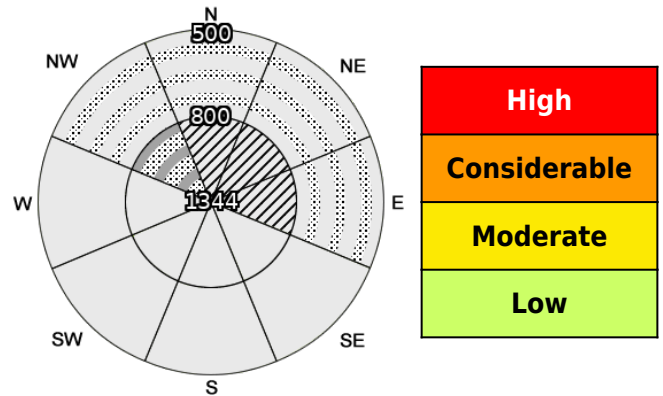

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will become increasingly unstable throughout the period. As the precipitation and rising temperatures become established during the morning, avalanches will occur, notably on steep North, North-East and East aspects above 800m. Localised instabilities will also be present on other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be High



**Forecast Weather Influences**

South-Westerly winds will increase and back Southerly. Showers overnight with heavier precipitation during the day. The freezing level will rise in the morning to around 1100m.
