

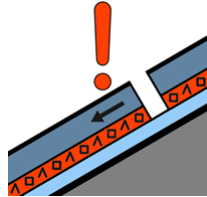

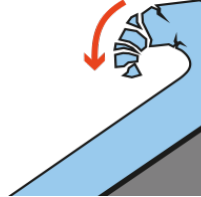
#### Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



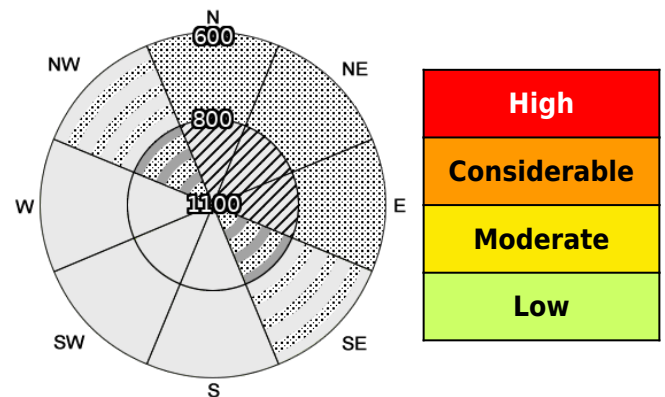
Persistent Weak Layers

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will continue to be deposited on mainly North to East aspects above 800 metres throughout the period. Stability will decrease further with the rising temperature during the afternoon. Avalanches will occur on steep slopes and gullies where the windslab accumulates. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will continue through the night. A band of snow, turning to rain below 800 metres during the afternoon, will cross the area through the day. Strong winds will be from the South-West.
