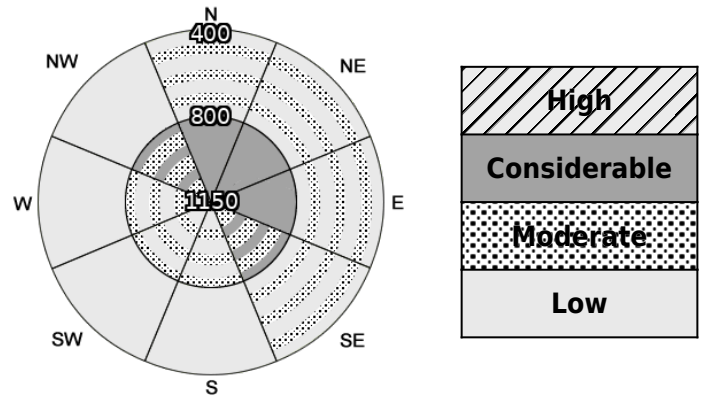

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further deposits of unstable windslab will form mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Other steep wind sheltered areas will be affected with unstable deposits due to cross loading. Unstable cornices will continue to form. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a gale force Westerly winds throughout the period with persistent snow showers above 300 metres. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.
