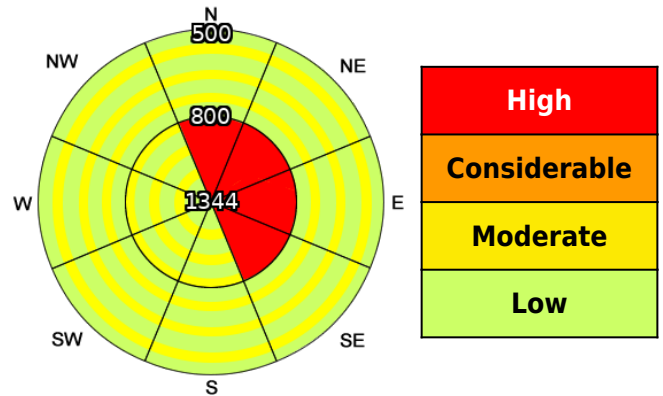

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of unstable snow will be present on many aspects. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North, North-East, East and South-East facing slopes and gullies above 800m. Avalanches will occur in these locations. Unstable cornices will also be present on these aspects. Localised accumulations will affect other locations. Wind scoured slopes will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers above 400m dying out overnight. Strong Westerly winds overnight easing and veering to the North-West during Monday
