

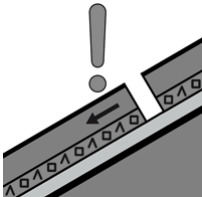

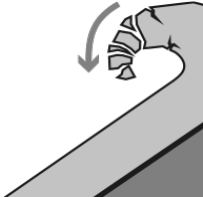

Wind Slab



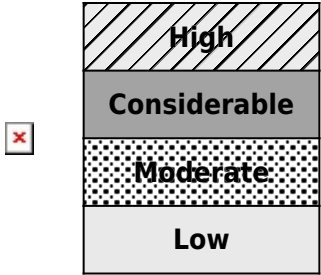
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Redistributed snow will build additional unstable windslab on mainly North - East to Southerly aspects above 700 metres especially on corrie rims, gully tops and wind sheltered aspects, other aspects will be affected also due to cross loading. Instabilities in the snowpack will remain on all aspects above 700 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Fresh winds will be North - West mostly, backing West North-West to West by the end of the day. Intermittent light snow showers are expected. The freezing level will be around 600 meters lowering to hover around 350 metres.

Comments

Sloughing and avalanches noted on North through East to Southerly aspects above 700 metres.
