





Wind Slab





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be some redistribution of existing snow. Localised areas of unstable windslab will continue to develop on East to South facing aspects above 650m. Cross loading will affect very sheltered areas on South-West and North-East facing slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

The wind will remain from the North North West and gradually ease during the next 24 hours. Light snow showers are forecast during the day with the freezing level at around 400m.

Comments

Good visibility in-between the frequent snow showers. Fresh snow overnight has made progress above 500m hard work.
