

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of unstable snow will be present mainly on steep North, North-East, East and South-East aspects above 800m. some further windslab development is likely on sheltered Southerly aspects during the day. Avalanches are likely in these locations. Localised accumulations will also be present in other locations. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate winds initially from the North but will slowly back North-West. The freezing level will lower to around 400m. There will be no significant precipitation
