

Wind Slab





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected in the snowpack. Significant areas of windslab of variable stability will remain on many North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Below 800 metres stability will be improved. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be another cold and generally settled day. The freezing level will be around 300 metres. Light to moderate winds will veer from the South-West to the North-West.
