

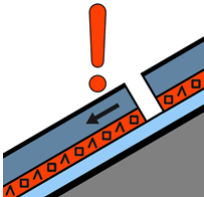

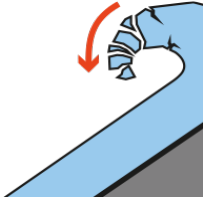

Wind Slab



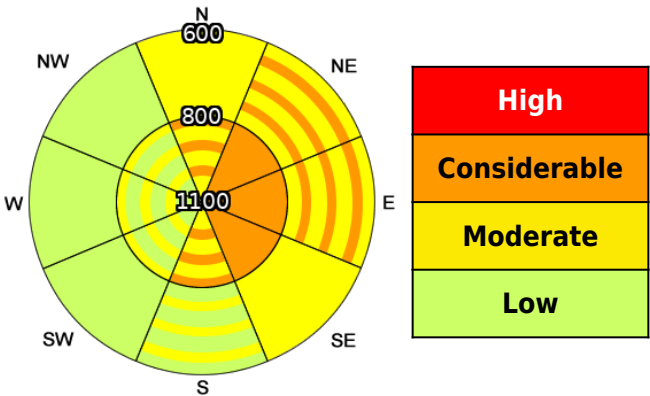
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of unstable windslab will persist and continue to build on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Large unstable cornices will overhang these aspects. More localised unstable windslab will be present on North and South aspects and at lower elevations. Ridges and slopes exposed to the wind will be mainly scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate mainly Westerly wind. Occasional snow showers. Freezing level around 300 metres.
