

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will persist mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres with large unstable cornices above these aspects. Localised areas of unstable windslab will also be found on North and South aspects. Many ridges and slopes that have been exposed to the wind are scoured, icy and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate West-North-West wind overnight becoming light Westerly. Mainly dry. Freezing level around 300 metres.
