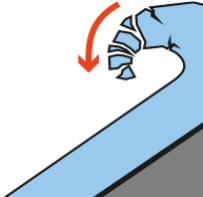

Wind Slab



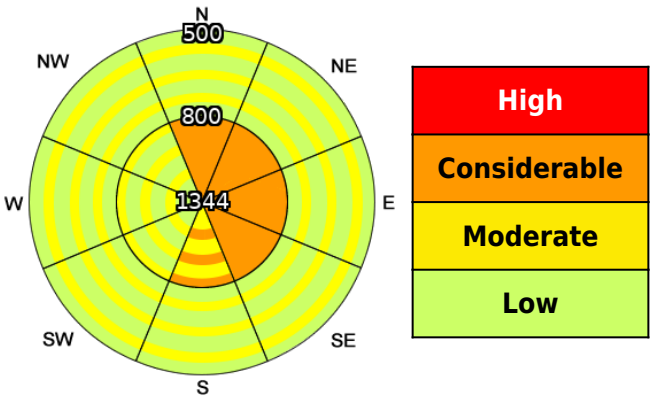
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Substantial areas of unstable windslab will persist on many North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Although it will continue to consolidate in the surface layers, instabilities will remain. Unstable cornices will overhang lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

The dry and settled conditions will continue through the period. Light winds from the North-West will back to the South-West through the afternoon. The freezing level will be around 300 metres.
