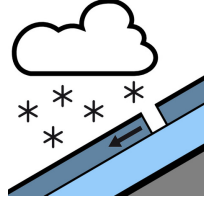

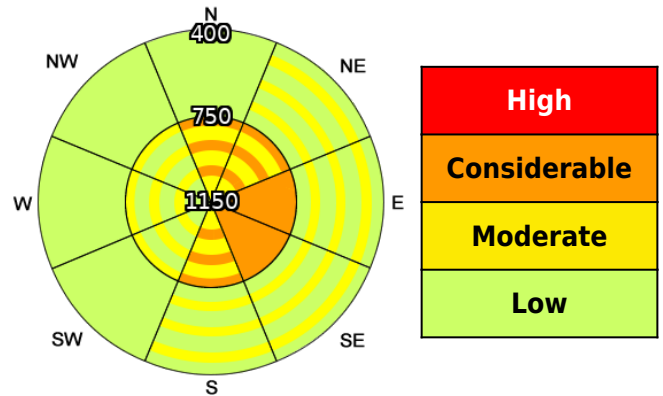

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some additional deposits of fresh unstable windslab will form on mainly North-East to South-East aspects above 750 metres. Existing areas of windslab on North through East to South aspects above 750 metres will remain unstable. Isolated deposits of unstable windslab will also persist below 750 metres on North through East to South aspects on steep wind sheltered slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The wind will be North-Westerly, backing Westerly fresh and easing. It will be dry throughout the period. The freezing level will be around 300 metres.
