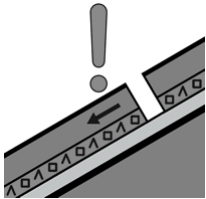


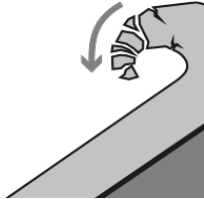

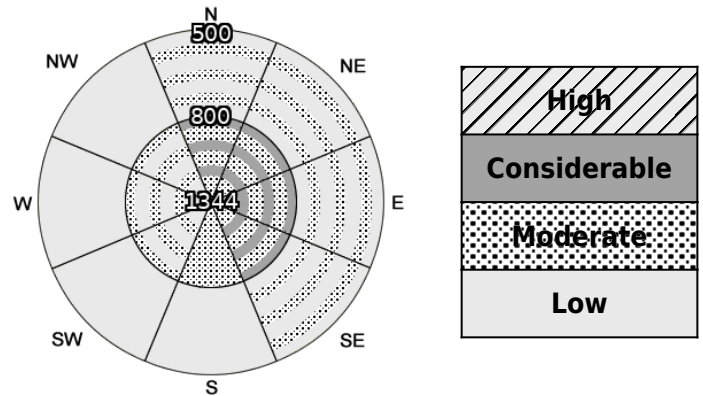
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of moderately bonded snow will be present, many on North, North-East, East and South-East aspects above 800m. Localised areas of poorly bonded snow will be present on some steeper slopes. Where the old snow is exposed, it is frozen and stable. Remaining cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry with light winds and the freezing level around 400m.
