

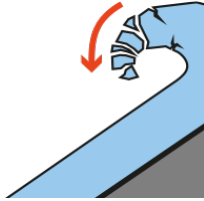

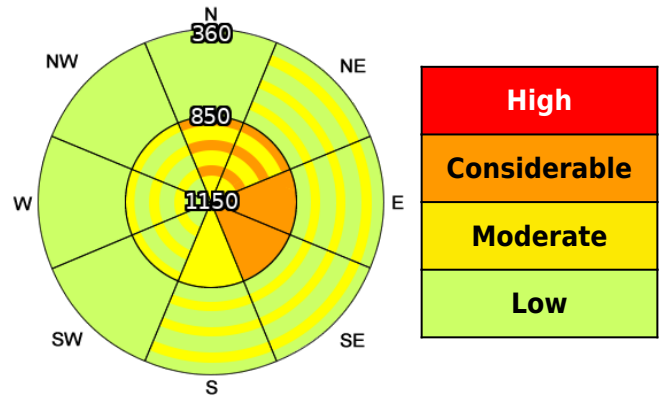

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Above 850 metres, instabilities will persist in the snowpack with areas of poorly bonded windslab present mainly on North-East to South Easterly aspects . Localised areas of windslab will also exist on North and South aspects. Unstable cornices will also exist mostly on Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain settled with dry and cold conditions through the forecast period. The winds will be moderate to fresh from the East-South-East. The freezing level will be around 300 metres with a hard overnight frost.

**Comments**

Many ridges and slopes that have been exposed to the strong winds are scoured, icy and stable snow-ice.
