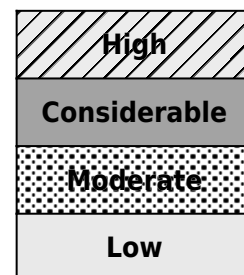
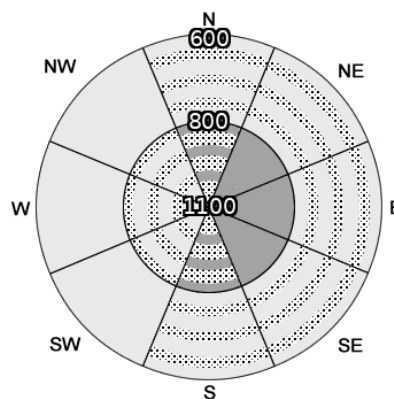
Persistent Weak Layers



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cold temperatures will maintain instability on steep North East to South East aspects above 800m. Localised instability on selected North and South aspects above the same altitude. Large cornices in place above most of these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and cold with generally light variable winds.

Comments

Good cover. Widely varying surface conditions often in close proximity near ridges, breakable crust, hard crust, hard slab and soft surface snow depending on altitude and aspect. Some very large cornices above the steeper East aspects of Beinn a Chaorainn.
