

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 27/02/2016


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weaknesses will persist in widespread areas of windslab mainly on North-East through East to South aspects above 650 metres and localised areas of moderately well bonded windslab will be present on North and South-West aspects. Steep summit slopes, ridge flanks and coire backwalls are most affected. Wind exposed ridges and summits are firm snow-ice in many places. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure will continue to dominate the weather giving settled cold and clear conditions with light Easterly winds. The freezing level will be around 500 metres during the day.

Comments

Good conditions for mountain days. There is a general cover of deep snow making for tiring progress although some ridges and summits remain scoured. Sunglasses recommended.
