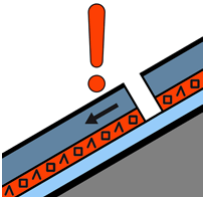

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 27/02/2016

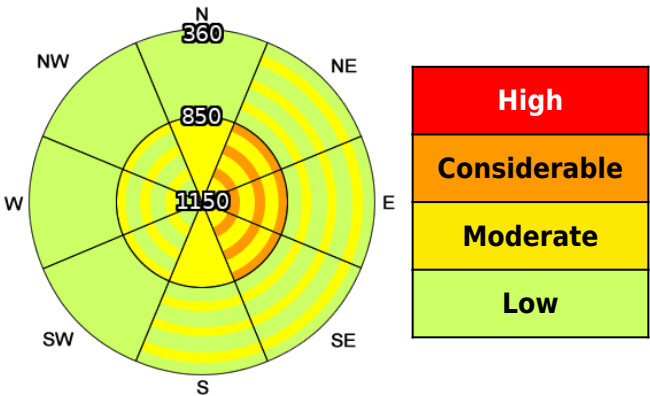
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be little change in the snowpack. Above 850 metres, instabilities will persist with areas of poorly bonded windslab present mainly on North-East to South Easterly aspects . Localised areas of windslab will also exist on North and South aspects. Unstable cornices are present mostly on Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Cold dry conditions will be maintained. Winds Light Easterly. Freezing level at 300 metres throughout the forecast period.

Comments

At higher elevations areas of hard snow-ice exists on many aspects.
