






Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of moderately bonded snow will be present, mainly on North, North-East, East and South-East aspects above 800m. Localised areas of unstable snow will be present on some steeper slopes with the same aspect. exposed old snow will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will remain generally light from an East or Southerly direction. It will be dry with the freezing level around 250m.
