

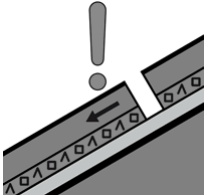

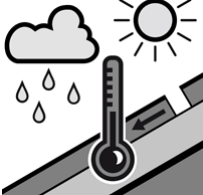
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



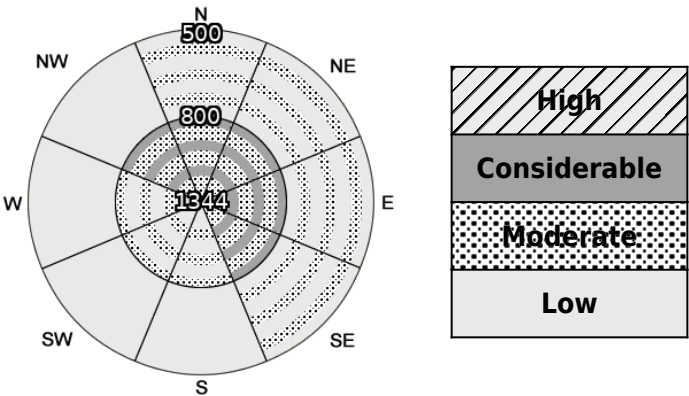
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable snow will be present, mainly on steep North-West, North, North-East, East and South-East aspects above 800m. Moderately bonded snow will be present on other slopes with the same aspects. Exposed old snow will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will slowly increase from the South, becoming strong over the summits. Freezing levels will rise to around 1000m with some light precipitation during the afternoon.
