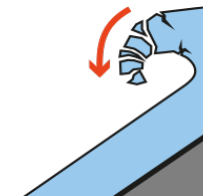

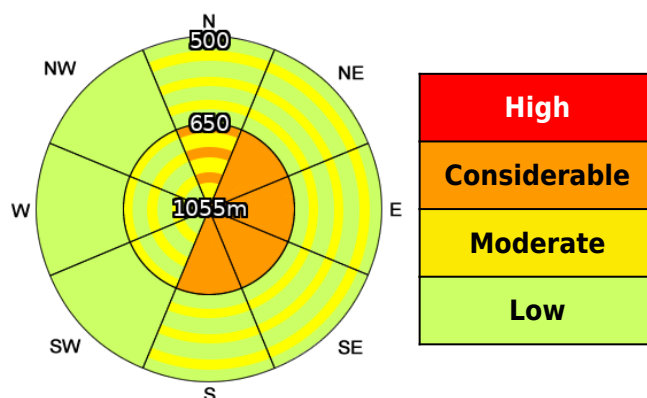

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New windslab instabilities will build on North through East to South aspects above 650 metres. Because of underlying instabilities and some cross loading all other aspects above 650 metres will be affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force Westerly winds will be variable, easing overnight and strengthening throughout the day to gale force North-Westerly. Snow showers are expected throughout forecast the period, heaviest during the day. Freezing level will hover around 300 metres throughout the night rising to 600 metres in the day.
