

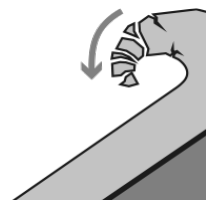

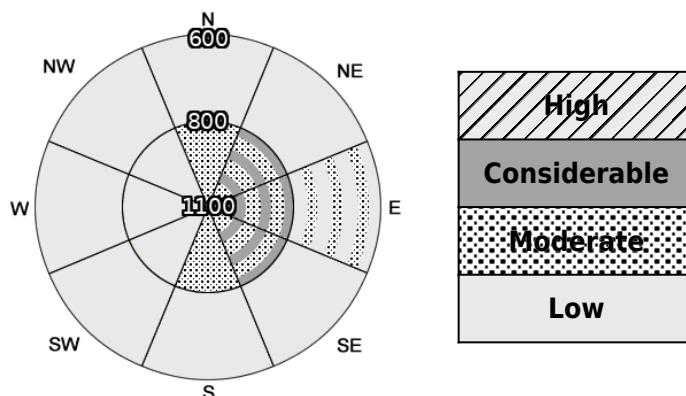

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The stabilising trend in the old moist snowpack will continue. New weak windslab will form on steep North through East to South East aspects above 800m. Deeper deposits expected high on steep East facing slopes and gullies. New weak cornices over steepest lee slopes. Wind exposed aspects will be hard or crusty and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Much colder with frequent snow showers on strong generally Westerly winds. Winds easing for a time during the day.

Comments

Thaw and rain went beyond summit levels last night and during the morning. Much colder temperatures in prospect overnight and during Weds.
